LITTLE FALLS — Mohawk Valley Center for the Arts, 410 Canal Place, presents the “Paper, Petal, Leaf and Metal” exhibition featuring current mixed media works by artist Mark Mastroianni. It opens with a reception from 5-7 p.m. Saturday, June 21 and runs through Friday, July 18.

Admission is free. Light refreshments will be served.

Mastroianni, an Ohio native who earned his bachelor’s degree from The Ohio State University in 1981, moved to New York City in 1983 to pursue his art career. There he worked as studio manager and assistant to renowned artist Malcolm Morley. His work has been exhibited in galleries throughout New York City, Europe, and the Midwest, and he is currently represented by Woodward Gallery in New York City.

Since 2001, Mastroianni has lived and worked in Cherry Valley with his wife and son, creating compelling mixed media pieces that incorporate natural and industrial materials.
